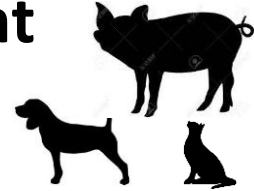




Standard Enrichment

Large Animal:
Cat Dog Swine Sheep Cow Chicken



*** All of these species typically benefit from increased novelty in enrichment
Toys may be rotated more frequently as time, supplies, and cage wash capacity allow***

Socially Housed	Single Housed in Room with Conspecifics	Single Housed Alone in Room
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Minimum 1 approved toy per animal <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Large groups (>6) may be exempt from 1 toy per animal requirement ● Rotate 1 x per week 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Minimum 2 approved <i>different</i> toys ● Rotate 2 x per week ● House so animals can visualize conspecifics <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ If not possible proceed as if single housed alone in room 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Minimum 2 approved <i>different</i> toys ● Rotate 2 x per week ● Mirror ● TV/Radio/Sound Machine <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ <8hrs a day ○ Only instrumental music or sound machine for chickens ○ Alter offering or discontinue if animals show signs of distress ● Additional socialization as appropriate Contact BWG for individualized plans as needed
<p>Items that animals cannot manipulate (tv/radio/sound machine, mirrors, murals, bubble machines etc) do not replace having and rotating approved toys in cage</p> <p>Items that are a required part of housing per the SOP (perches, beds, mats, bowls, etc.) do not replace having and rotating approved toys in cage</p>		

Use a yellow acetate on cage or back of the door to note changes to enrichment

If enrichment is withheld or reduced a posted SToP form is also required

YOU ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR ASSESSING SAFETY AND APPROPRIATENESS OF ENRICHMENT ON A DAILY BASIS
 Select size of approved toys appropriate for that individual animal
 Remove broken or damaged items
